





















Timeline:

- Preliminary projects

 - Surficial aquifer level monitoring
- Met with faculty and students from schools
 - Winter 2013
 - Assessed interests
 - Explored how students could learn from projects
- Applied for over \$2 million in grant funding
 - Winter 2013



Timeline:

 - Spring 2013
 - Needs

- Determine evaluation methods
