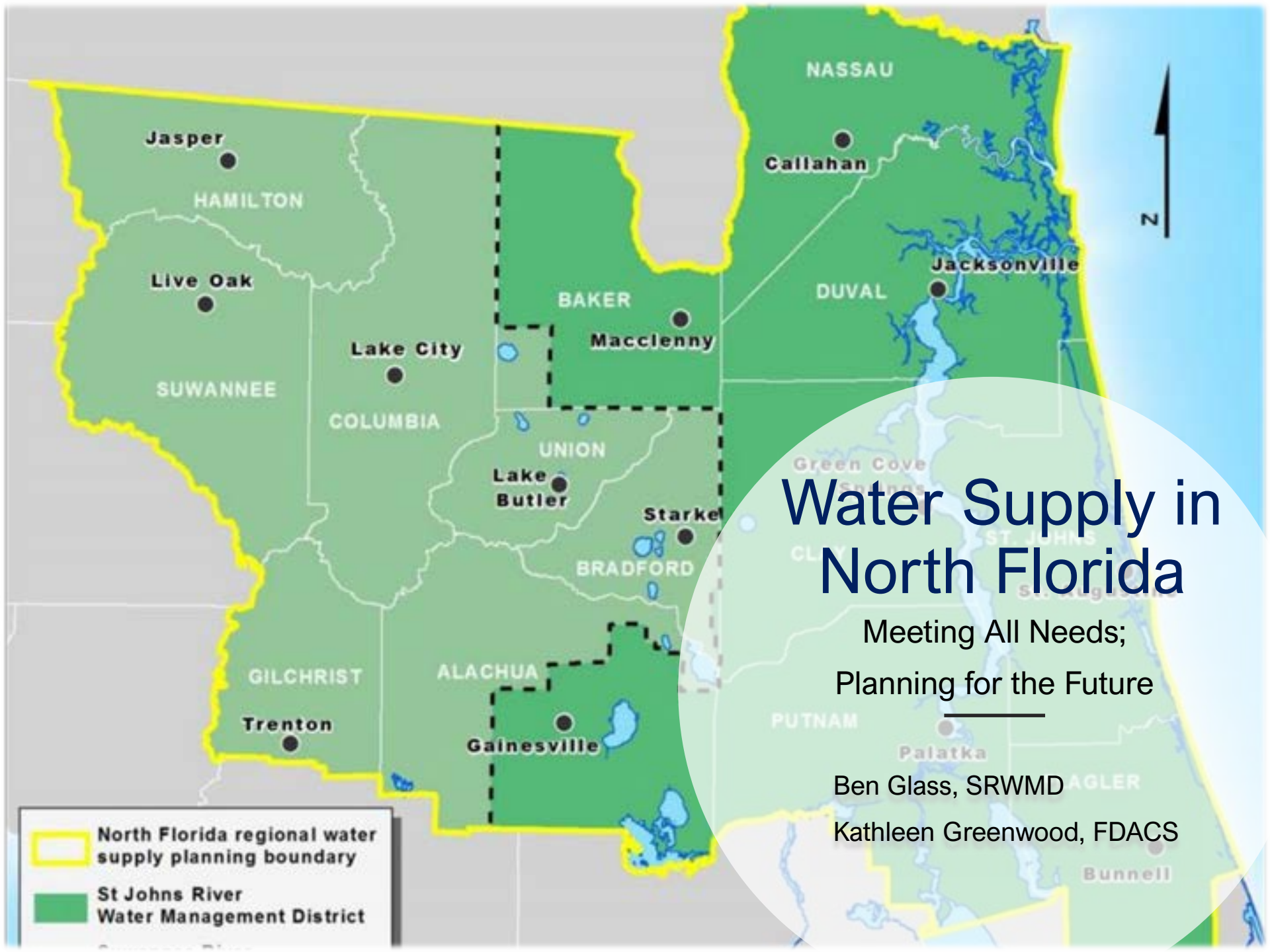

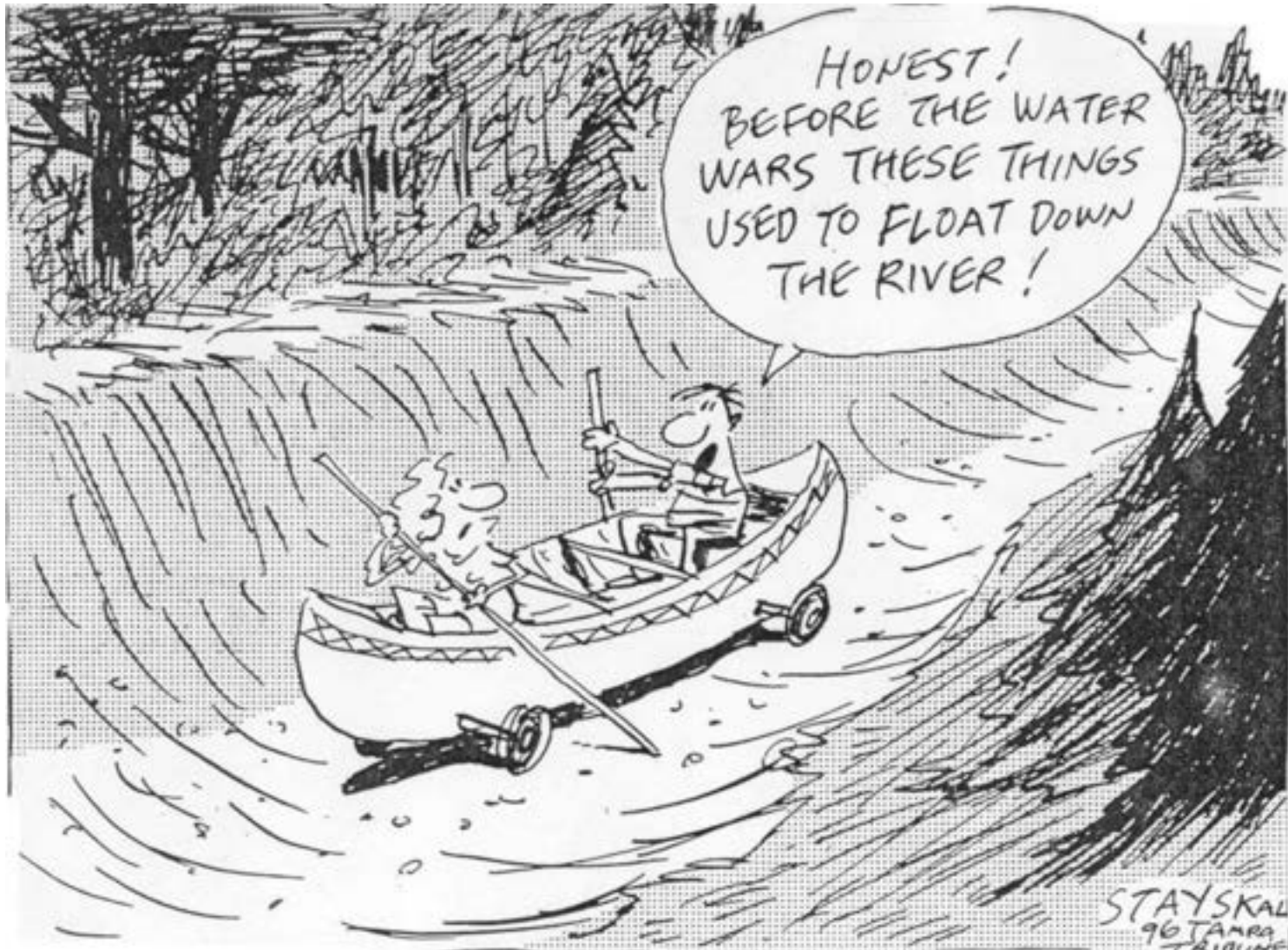

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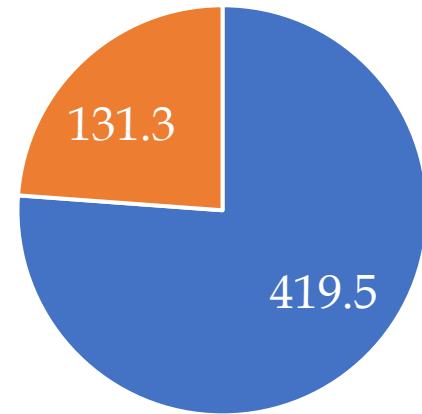


What's Happening in the Region?

- Withdrawals in SJRWMD affecting water resources in SRWMD
- Public water supply and agriculture are largest users
- Agricultural stakeholders have not actively participated in water supply planning
- Existing sources of water will be inadequate to meet future demand without planning accordingly

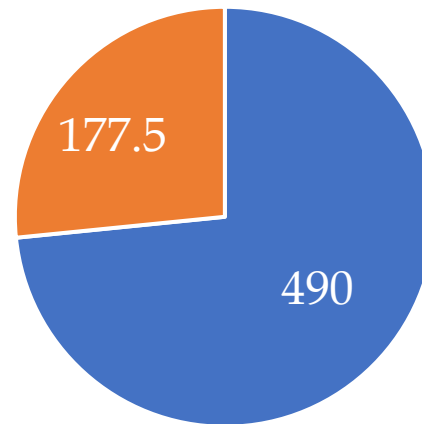
2010 Water Use (mgd)

2035 Water Use (mgd)

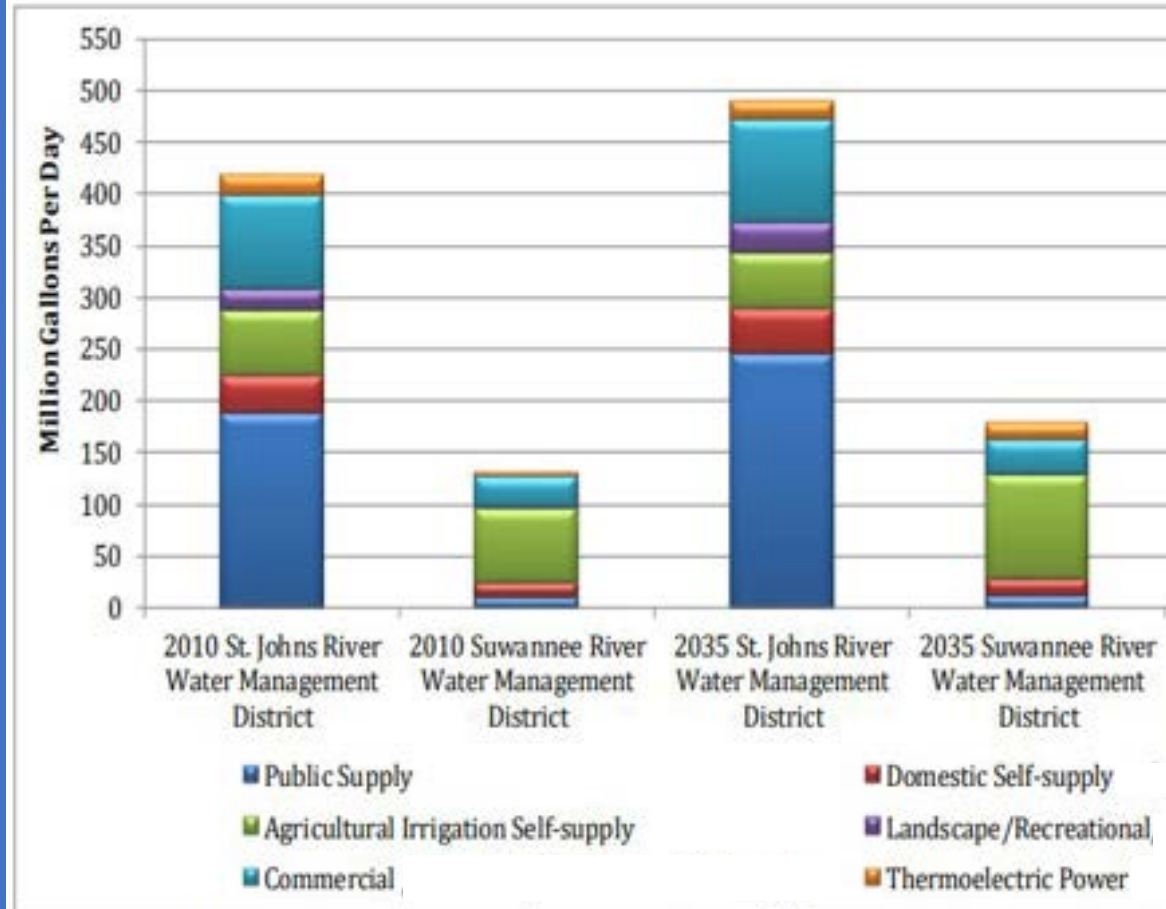
Total Water Use

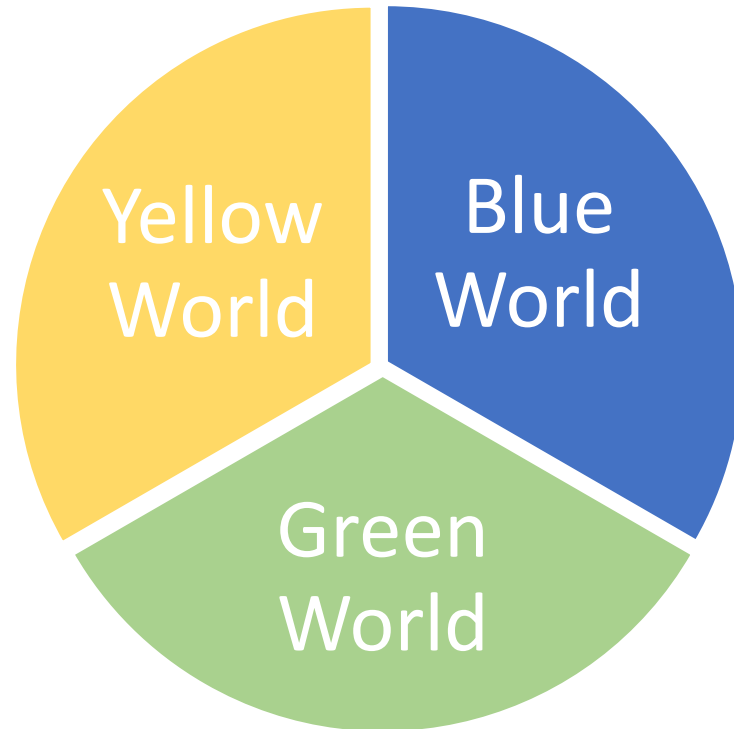

Lessons Learned
