





Lots of concerns....

Debrief – Process Agenda

Activity	Description	Time
Welcome	This activity will welcome everyone to the meeting and do a short check-in.	5 minutes
Debrief – Zoom session	This activity will allow facilitators who participated via Zoom to share their experience/overall perspectives of the meeting.	10-15 minutes
Debrief – In-person session	This activity will allow facilitators who participated in the in-person session via to share their experience/overall perspectives of the meeting.	10-15 minutes
Combination debrief	This activity will have participants provide an overall perspective of: • Key takeaways from both sessions • Common themes • Any differences • Overall lessons learned about the concerns of the community	15 minutes
Next steps	This activity will allow everyone to brainstorm the next steps in the data collection process. This will address: • What should the next steps be in the process?	15-20 minutes
